Probable Ineffective Control - Likely to lead to officer safety being threatened and possibly lead to escalation of force beyond what was necessary to control the situation.

 **Zone of Effective Control** - Situations are dynamic and fluid and officers must be prepared to escalate and de-escalate as the situation warrants.

Probable Excessive Control - An inappropriate response to the amount of resistance encountered.
