



**Swarthmore Bicycle and Pedestrian Task Force  
Proposed Swarthmore Bike Network Spring 2010**

Darkened streets = proposed Swarthmore Bicycle Network, based on suggestions from Swarthmore residents. Lots of rides—from easy to hard, short ride to long ride—are possible using this Network. We'll create a website for users, with printable map and safety guidelines. Signs near road will mark the route: Bike Route and Bikes Yield to Pedestrians (the latter signs to be placed wherever the Network intersects a marked pedestrian crossing).

Includes four "hill challenge" loops:

1. Riverview Avenue by Henderson Field up to Ogden; turn left on Ogden to Guernsey and loop around to Thayer and then back to Ogden and back down Riverview.
2. The Cedar Lane hill, beginning at the stoplight on College Ave. and 320: head west up College Avenue then turn right onto Cedar.
3. The Elm Avenue hill off of Walnut Lane, going down towards the Crum and back (a one-block hill, go down and then back up).
4. The Yale Avenue hill down to Crum Creek and back.
