Place in compostable, biodegradable paper bags with green YARDWASTE sticker attached. Stickers available for \$1 at Borough Hall and Swarthmore Hardware. Call the Borough Office at 610-543-4599 or by e-mail at [swarthmore2@comcast.net](mailto:swarthmore2@comcast.net) for collection date. In November and December there will be no collection of bags due to curbside leaf collection.

The Swarthmore Recycling Center, located at 121 Dartmouth Avenue, is open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday, and from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. All material except plastic and yard waste is accepted at the Recycling Center.
