The Annex at Swarthmore Music.

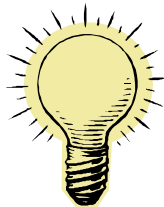
The Annex at Swarthmore Music has opened with the goal of better serving their growing student population. Located at 13 Park Avenue (above Co-Ed Hair Studio), the increased space and size of **The Annex** will enable Swarthmore Music to introduce new classes.

Programs have already started in The Annex and are diverse to fit many needs. Already introduced is a program called "**Music Time**", which is for children ages birth through seven. It introduces children to singing, learning rhythms and sharing music with other children. The program is Tuesdays 9:30 to 10:15 in the morning.

There is also have an **acoustic jam** every 1st Thursday of the month, sponsored by Marty Spiegel. People are encouraged to bring an instrument, to sing and play along. The session starts at 8:30pm and goes for a few hours. The 2nd Friday of every month there will be a drum circle at 7:30pm. Members will learn basic rhythms and share in an open drumming circle.
